
The International Energy Agency (IEA) highlighted three key conversations that are integral for ministers, CEOs and industry leaders to consider when incorporating new initiatives and strategies to move the energy dialogue forward.

- The rising demand for services that energy provides due to a growing global population
- The recognition that oil and natural gas play critical roles in today's energy and economic systems
- The imperative to reduce energyrelated emissions in line with international climate targets

Global population growth of 1.7 billion and rising standards of living in developing and newly industrialized nations will drive growing energy demand.

As the demand for higher sustainability and cleaner energy increases across the world, nations are coming together to take ownership of the global climate effort. With the anticipation that energy demand will increase by 1 per cent every year and targets have been set in the Paris Agreement, a fully complete energy mix is vital in moving business and collaboration forward in the coming years. Leading pace with this transition of a diversified energy mix, the Global Petroleum Show changed its name to the Global Energy Show in February 2020. The name **Global Energy Show** reflects the industry's continued evolution, as the Show builds upon significant technological and sustainable achievements driven by oil and gas and moves to encompass alternative sources. As the third name-change in its 54-year history, the Global Energy Show is making this change to ensure we can continue to grow our relevance and position as the key platform where buyers and sellers, policy makers and leaders make decisions that shape the future of energy.

CANADIAN OIL AND GAS SNAPSHOT - A MARKET ON THE RISE

Forecast \$2 Billion Increase in Upstream Investment in 2020

Capital spending in the oil and natural gas industry is expected to be about \$2 billion higher in 2020 compared to last year. This represents a four per cent increase in capital investment in the conventional side, and an eight per cent increase in the oil sands, according to the Canadian Association of Petroleum Producers (CAPP).

Conventional oil and natural gas capital investment for 2020 is forecast at **\$25.4 billion**, up from an estimated \$24.4 billion last year.

Capital investment in the oil sands is forecast at **\$11.6 billion in 2020**, up from an estimated \$10.7 billion in 2019. This marks the first time in five years that oil sands capital spending is expected to experience an upswing.

Overall for the oil and natural gas sector, total capital investment this year is forecast at \$37 billion, up from an estimated \$35.1 billion in 2019, for a combined increase of six per cent in 2020.

Pipelines Moving Forward:

With the Line 3 project scheduled to come on stream in late 2020, the Trans Mountain Expansion underway, and pre-construction activities ongoing for Keystone XL, there is potential for medium and long-term production growth with access to global markets and expanded transport capacity into the United States. **source CAPP Feb 2020*

World energy demand is forecasted to increase by **24% by 2040**. As a global leader, Canada provides environmentally and socially responsible products to help meet the growing energy needs and help displace fuels from less-responsively produced sources.


Increasingly, thoughtful leaders from industry, government and public affairs understand the world needs a different course for the future of energy and the economy than the one it is on.
